Quilt Show Entry Rules

1. All quilters regardless of age are eligible to enter. Membership in HSV Quilt Guild is **not** required. To enter a quilt, return the completed registration form and the non-refundable entry fee by the entry deadline. Quilt registration will begin **April 1, 2022** and end on **July 15, 2022**.
2. All quilts must consist of three layers: top, batting, backing, and must be quilted through all three layers. Exception to this rule are quilts entered in the Miscellaneous category.
3. A maximum of 200 quilt registrations will be accepted in the order they are received.
Entry form and non-refundable fee must be received by midnight July 15, 2022.
4. The show committee reserves the right to combine and/or divide categories based on number of entries.
5. If the quilt is not an original design, credit must be given to the designer.
6. All quilts must be clean and free of pet hair, smoke, or other strong odors.
7. No tied quilts are allowed in any category.
8. False backs are not allowed, except in the Miscellaneous category. See definitions.
9. A label with entrant's name, address, and phone number must be attached to the bottom right side on the back of the quilt. The label should be covered with a piece of fabric attached with basting stitches so that identification is hidden during the judging process. No pins are allowed.
10. Quilt Hanging Sleeve

- All quilts must have a 4-inch hanging sleeve attached. If the quilt is **longer** than 90 inches the hanging sleeve should be placed so the quilt will hang 90 inches from the floor. Excess of the quilt will be draped over the top pole.
- Quilts **wider** than 90 inches must have a split sleeve with the opening at mid-point.
- Quilts without a proper hanging sleeve will be judged, but will not be hung in the show, nor given ribbon consideration.

11. **Four** quilts may be entered by the same entrant, but only one per category.
12. Entrant must have actively participated in the construction and/or quilting of the quilt. No third-party quilts will be allowed.
13. All participants who worked on the quilt should be listed on entry form. The exception is in the Group category where many people may have participated.
14. Quilt insurance is the responsibility of the entrant.
15. Quilts must be completed after September 2019.
16. Entry Fees
 - **HSV Quilt Guild Member** - \$10 per quilt
 - For **three** quilts entered - \$25
 - For **four** quilts entered - \$35 (A member is defined as a paid member of HSV Quilt Guild in good standing on April 1, 2022.)
 - Non-member - \$20 per quilt
 - Junior - no fee
17. The Best of Show award will be selected from first place winners in each category except the BOM/Kit category and the Junior category.
18. Ribbons will be awarded to the entrant with an additional ribbon for the quilter if different from the entrant. Group quilts will be awarded only one ribbon.

19. Decisions of the judge(s) are final.
20. At “turn in” each quilt must be in a fabric case with entrant’s name, address, and phone number clearly marked on the case. Pillow cases work well for this purpose. No plastic, or paper cases will be accepted.
21. Quilt Turn-In will be from 1:30 - 4:00 pm on Monday, September 19, 2022. Location will be announced at a later date.
22. Entrant’s shipping quilts will be contacted after the registration form is accepted. Shipping, both to and from the show, is the responsibility of the entrant. Also shipping insurance is the responsibility of the entrant. Shipped quilts will be returned the following week.
23. Quilt pick up will take place immediately after take-down is completed at the close of the show on Saturday, September 24, 2022.
